Permit for alcohol use on town owned property- Briefly discussed

Mitchell- We will have to come up with a form for permitting alcohol use on town property for organizations and family gatherings. There is nothing stated in zoning for this but there is a town ordinance.

Town Hall Camera System-

Proposal received from Allan Treadwell of Twin Bridges for installment of four camera security systems on the outside of the building, monitored from any of the town hall computers.


