Highway Department:

Hammond Hollow; UNH person is going to come on Wednesday, May 13th to meet with Bazarnicki and Maguire to review the road. Maguire plans to fill in the pot holes with millings.

Trucks; After picking up the Chevy Duramax Highway Department crew started driving home and decided to turn around because something did not seem right. After the dealership inspected the truck, there was a bad lock out hub and they replaced it. Maguire picked up the truck and drove it back to the Highway Department shop and the vibration is still there. We bought the warranty for these issues. While the truck underneath is still clean, Maguire wants to oil it once its fixed.

Steves Auto wrote up a list on the Kenworth. Maguire is planning to steer away from it and look for something else.

Maguire wants to put his transmission in the red truck ^{for Face} but it would need to match up and be able to fit. Maguire to research to see if the transmission will fit and continue research and quotes on other trucks. Maguire is going to send the Dodge to Gilsum Garage to weld the cross member back. Gilsum Garage also may be interested in buying it.

Speed Limit Signs; Maguire is working to get permission from the NHDOT to install poles.

Spring Street; Robin Cantara asked Louder about if a top coat will be put on Spring Street. To be discussed.

Rymes Property; Boundary Line Adjustment: Hrabovsky brought forward emails from Sarah Clark from Shaneen and Gordon and Liz Rymes, to see if there was a Public Notice and Selectboard approval for the boundary line adjustment. After reviewing the minutes from Selectboard meeting June 9th 2025 and the Planning Board meeting August 14th 2025, the Selectboard had the stipulation of Note 7 per the plans that were brought before the Planning Board that were approved. It appears that it was overlooked as Note 7 was not followed through with the petition and not brought to town meeting. Hrabovsky to let Clark and Rymes know of the discussion.


