**Highway Department:**

Street Name Signs; Maguire reports they are rusted and especially the ones along Route 10. Maguire is going to gather quotes for the budget for next year.

Hammond Hollow Road; It was questioned on how much will we pay the driver, as we are on a \$2000 budget. Discussed how many hours do we need the person for. Maguire wants to start working on the ditch on Hammond Hollow. Maguire wants to know if he can take his truck and bring the dirt to Marlow as it will need written permission for removal to another location. Harlen Maguire gives permission and Selectboard does not problem with it going to Maguire.

Chevy Duramax; The mechanic is ordering a new differential and it is on backorder. Currently do not know the estimated time.

Phone; Maguire is currently changing phone carriers and he has been without a phone for a week as he is waiting on a SIM card.

**Fire Department:** The 2013 Tanker International truck went down over the weekend and it turned out to be the batteries. One battery was dead but it affected the other two. Denehy bought 3 new ones.

Dry hydrant request: Denehy informed them of the steps <sup>would take</sup> would take. The landowners were hoping the town would dredge and put in a dry hydrant when they did that. *6.2*

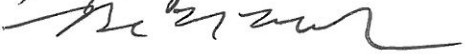
