Highway Department:

Hammond Hollow Road; Bazarnicki presented the report that UNH did for us. Selectmen reviewed report. Maguire asked if he could hire outside labor to run one of the trucks; we have enough money in the budget, just need to check about driver insurance since they will be running one of our trucks.

Dump: Lawnmowing; Maguire asks when the Selectboard would like to mow, suggested at least twice a year.

Murphy motions that the Highway Department can hire outside labor up to \$2000 for the Hammond Hollow project.

Fire Department: Formal request for a dry hydrant on Nash Corner Road. Denehy to ask for more specific information if they are looking for the town to do it or on their own. It would need to be considered a fire pond and they will need to do more research. To put in a dry hydrant, it is a permit by notification. Denehy would fill out permit with landowner and send it to DES but it would be \$600.

Garnet Court: Murphy found deeds up to 1953, still working on the ones back until 1948. Bank owned in 1953. Discussed the various options of obtaining a right of way or to make it a town owned road. Denehy to discuss options with the Rec committee and report back to the Selectboard.

Rymes Property; Boundary Line Adjustment: Held first public hearing with the Selectboard for the sale of town property to be acquired by the Rymes. No public comments.

Louder motions to accept pistol permit R713355, background check came back with no record of domestic violence or felonies.
