Highway Department:

Hammond Hollow; UNH was supposed to fix the expansion joints on the bridge. Bazarnicki to call Henry Underwood and follow up. Ditches are done. There is concern with the amount of water coming out of the bank and Maguire would like to put underdrain in. Discussed what the underdrain would look like and how it would work.

Carroll Concrete; Need to set up an account. Maguire bought blocks he needed. Lenoir Law to fill out application to have an account for the future.

Speed Limit Signs; We put one sign up so far on Alstead Hill Road. Maguire will need to cut back some brush and will talk to Ralph Jernberg about it.

Belvedere, Vessel Rock and Pinnacle Road; Maguire put some cold pack down on these roads using the grader. We will need to buy tires for the grader sooner rather than later.

Salt Shed; The sides have rotted and are falling in. Maguire would like to put up pressure treated wood and galvanized screws.

Chevy Duramax; The auto shop is working on the carrier of the driveshaft.

Fire Department:

Fire Inspections; Discussed more, Dee to review.

Sprinkler Plans; State Fire Marshal is the one to do their inspection. Typically, the State Fire Marshal is the one to review school/commercial buildings fire safety plans. The state needs to approve the plans. To be discussed more with the school.
